### INTRODUCTION

This week, we'll be studying part of Jesus' final address to his disciple's before his crucifixion. We're at the center of the gospel here, at the center of Jesus' desires for us. What Jesus wants for us is exactly the same as what he wanted for his first disciples: that we would abide in him so that our joy might be full.

## READ & DISCUSS

READ: John 15:1-11

<u>DISCUSS:</u> Why do you think Jesus uses the image of a vine and fruit here? Are there other places in Scripture where images like that are used?

<u>DISCUSS:</u> "If you abide in me, and my words abide in you, ask whatever you wish, and it will be done for you." What does that mean? Do you believe it?

<u>DISCUSS</u>: "These things I have spoken to you, that my joy may be in you, and that your joy may be full." Do Jesus' commands here seem likely to lead to joy to you? Why or why not?

#### REFLECT & APPLY

<u>DISCUSS:</u> What would it look like to abide more deeply in Jesus for each of you? Where do you most want his joy to fill your life?

PRAY
