# INTRODUCTION

This week we are talking about politics. For some of us this is an area where we feel very comfortable. For others that might not be true. But as always, Jesus is going to challenge the way we view politics and the government. He is going to give us a new and more powerful way to interact with this subject. First, let's take sometime to pray that we would have ears to hear what Jesus is saying and how he is calling us to apply it to our lives.

# TRUTH

## READ

Mark 12:1-12

## DISCUSS

- Why did the tenants do what they did?
- How does this parable shed light on how we operate in a political system?

# GRACE

## DISCUSS

In this parable, the tenants are more concerned about using the vineyard to gain their own power rather than serving its owner. This rings true today. People often seek power before they seek to serve others. Jesus showed us another way. The gospel flips this paradigm upside down. Jesus found power by first serving those around him. What specific examples in Jesus' life do you see him living this out?

# CHANGE

## DISCUSS

- Where in your life do you fall into the lie that we must use power to bring about what we want to see in the world?
- How do we wield love and service instead of power when we interact with the government or the world?

# PRAYER

Praise Jesus for being different than the world and for ushering a Kingdom that doesn't use power to get what it wants, but love and service. Pray that you would be listening to the Holy Spirit this week and how he is calling you to live out love and service in every area of your lives.

## DISCIPLESHIP CHECK-IN

- Have you read your Bible and prayed consistently the past week?
- Who is one lost person you're praying would come to faith?
