## READ & DISCUSS

READ: John 4:23-24

DISCUSS:

- Jesus uses the term “true worshippers.” What do you think a true worshipper is?
- If true worshippers exist then so do false worshippers. What do you think a false worshipper could be?
- What do you think it means to worship in spirit and truth?

## REFLECT & APPLY

DISCUSS:

- To worship in spirit and truth means to know Christ through his word and to have a spirit that treasures Christ. The truth about Christ can stir our spirit and emotions and our spirit and emotions can remind us about the truth of Christ. Where in your life can you let the truth of Christ stir your spirit? Or where in your life can your let your spirit and emotions remind you of truth?
- Read Ezekiel 36:26. The temptation when we read a passage like the one from Jon is to hear Jesus saying that we need to worship him better, but the beauty of Christ and the gospel is that he gives us the ability to worship. Jesus is the fulfillment of the Ezekiel verse. How does it encourage you to know that Jesus gives us new hearts that will want to worship him?
