READ & DISCUSS

READ	DISCUSS
Ecclesiastes 7:1-14	Wisdom makes life go better in general, because God designed life that way. Describe an area of your own life in which growing in knowledge and wisely applying that knowledge has led to good outcomes in your life.
Ecclesiastes 7:23-29	When man tries to search out "the scheme of things," it doesn't turn out well. We can't ascend to a God's-eye view, and trying to twists our hearts. When you consider these verses, in what ways do you think trying to grasp "the scheme of things" can twist a person's heart?
Acts 17:22-31	If we're going to heed the teacher's warning, we must do four things: receive the teacher's instruction; resist the anxiety of culture; foster a relationship with the wise One; reinforce this within spiritual family. Given what Paul says to the people of Athens, why is it much better to embrace the wise practices above, rather than seeking wisdom alone?

PRAYER

Spend time meditating on and glorifying the resurrected Jesus. Pray for courage to reject the worldly practice of seeking wisdom alone, and rather walk with God, the wise One.
